

OUTREACH AND MISSIONS

What is LoveINC (Love In the Name of Christ) and how does Trinity participate? LoveINC is a faith based non-profit that assists churches and other community organizations in meeting the needs of people in the local area. Currently, 22 churches in Lapeer participate along with several other service ministries.

In the past, when a person came to the church requesting assistance, the church staff would do their best to determine what help was needed and what they were able to offer. Now, however, the staff directs the person to LovelNC, located on North M-24, just past Davis Lake Rd., behind the Church of Christ. The staff at LovelNC evaluates the individual or family on a case-by-case basis with care and respect and determines the needs. To qualify for assistance they must be at or below 150% of the U.S. poverty level. For a family of 4 that would be \$48,400.00 annual income. A family could need help with food, clothing, housing, utilities, transportation, personal care items, or furniture. No church could provide for all of these, but LovelNC knows which services are available and where. LovelNC then provides a voucher to the church or agency requesting their specific help for the need. This frees churches from the burden of trying to determine who, and how to help.

LoveINC lives by the motto: A hand up, not a hand out. They work with other agencies to help resolve the problems that lead to the need to ask for help. The Refuge, Pregnancy Center, Salvation Army, LACADA, are examples.

Trinity Methodist Church is known as a giving and praying congregation. It seems, no need or request goes unanswered once the congregation is made aware of it. It might amaze and challenge you to know that above and beyond our budget needs to maintain the church, our food and personal needs pantry is receiving requests of \$2,500.00-\$3,000.00 per month! Who knew? Now you know.

We pray you will continue your faithful giving to the General Fund of the church to maintain our facility and staff, but also consider the needs beyond our walls. As a body of Christ, we can rise together as the Holy Spirit leads, to provide for the "hidden" needs we have in our community.
